La façon d'envisager le progrès en général, l'attitude des syndicats, des employeurs et des salariés ainsi que la documentation actuellement disponible sont synthétisées dans cette brochure.

Se basant sur une analyse des phénomènes démographiques en Angleterre durant un siècle, J. Saville confirme certains faits observés. Une partie de la population rurale s'est transplantée dans les régions urbaines non seulement parce que les opportunités de travail y sont plus grandes mais aussi en raison du déclin économique des régions rurales. La réduction des populations rurales est d'autant plus grave qu'elle affecte surtout les groupes d'âge inférieurs à 40 ans et qu'elle provoque un déséquilibre des taux des sexes, les femmes étant plus attirées vers les centres urbanisés. La solution du problème se trouve dans l'équipement des régions rurales; l'auteur fait remarquer qu'ici se pose la question du choix des localités à aménager. L'ouvrage contient aussi une étude détaillée des South Hams : dix-huit paroisses typiquement rurales.

Schoeck développe la thèse suivante : prétendre se borner au possible présente le danger de mener à une action néfaste parce qu'elle flatte certaines attitudes et peut être exploitée à des fins de propagande ou en faveur du militarisme. Il en résulte des situations pires que celles qui sont la conséquence de décisions fermes, plus ou moins mal accueillies. Ceci vaut aussi bien sur le plan national que sur le plan international et également au niveau des relations Est-Ouest.
